Spend the night aboard the 1882 square-rigged training ship *Joseph Conrad*. The next morning, have breakfast at the Galley Restaurant, and return to the *Joseph Conrad* to participate in a flag raising ceremony and a group activity with Museum staff. Then, spend the day exploring Mystic Seaport.

Typical Schedule:

- 6:50 p.m. Program begins with an orientation. Evening activities may include knot tying, scrimshaw, movies, and evening walk, or games. Pizza snack!
- 10 p.m. Sleep aboard the historic square rigged ship *Joseph Conrad*.
- 7:30 a.m. Reveille, clean ship, stow gear in cars.
- 8:15 a.m. Breakfast in our Galley Restaurant.
- 9:00 a.m. Ticketing and introduction to Mystic Seaport, group activity with Museum staff.
- 9:30 a.m. - on... Enjoy a day on your own exploring the museum.

Cost

\$75 per person includes overnight accommodations aboard the school ship *Joseph Conrad*, pizza snack, evening activities, craft materials, breakfast, a Mystic Seaport patch, and two days admission to Mystic Seaport.

Eligibility

Open to all cub scouts, siblings and parents.
