(From personal experience 6-year olds love this!)

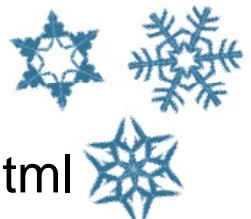

Directions

To Nashoba Snowtube Park (from the Congregational Church in Mansfield)

52.2 mi – about 54 mins

Note: The tubing entrance is a separate from the Nashoba Ski area.

1. Head west on West St toward Union St 0.4 mi
2. Turn left at School St 0.5 mi
3. Turn left at RT-140 0.4 mi
4. Merge onto I-495 N via the ramp to Marlborough 49.5 mi
5. Take exit 31 for State Hwy 119 E toward Acton 0.3 mi
6. Turn left at Great Rd/RT-119 Destination will be on the left 1.2 mi

To Gillogly's House (from the Snowtube Park)

1 Patten Lane, Westford 5 mi – about 10 mins

1. Head northwest on Great Rd/RT-119/RT-2A toward Robinson Rd 1.0 mi
2. Turn right at King St/RT-110 & Continue to follow RT-110 1.4 mi
3. Turn left at Concord Rd/RT-225 1.4 mi
4. Slight right at Country Rd 0.6 mi
5. Turn right at Patten Rd (& go past Westford Academy) 0.5 mi
6. Turn right at Patten Ln Destination will be on the right 459 ft
